

Community Engagement Programme

- Consultancy – student teams answer project briefs, which centre on challenges organisations face
- Additional support provided by the LSE and an alumni mentor

Summer Volunteering Scheme for Disabled Students

- Runs beginning of July to middle of September
- Individual volunteering placements

Research Volunteering Scheme

- Connecting charities with students to complete research
- Charities submit a question for students to answer

Student-led projects

- Students can run their own volunteering project with training and support from the Volunteer Centre

One-off Volunteering

- Numerous one-off opportunities throughout all three terms
- A mixture of on and off campus

Student Volunteering Ambassadors

- Team of LSE students who promote volunteering to their peers

Fairs, Charity Tuesdays and other events

- Around 90-100 partners on campus each year to recruit
- Giving Tuesday and Student Volunteering Week
